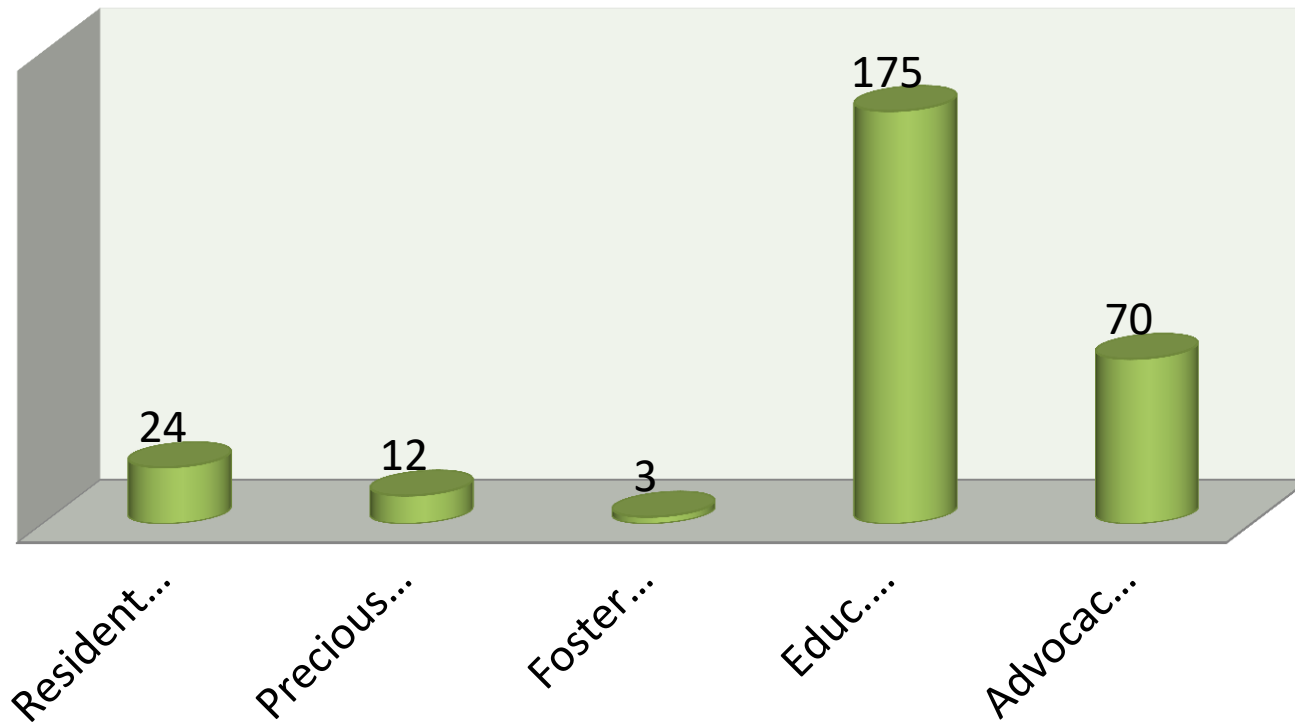

of the organization.







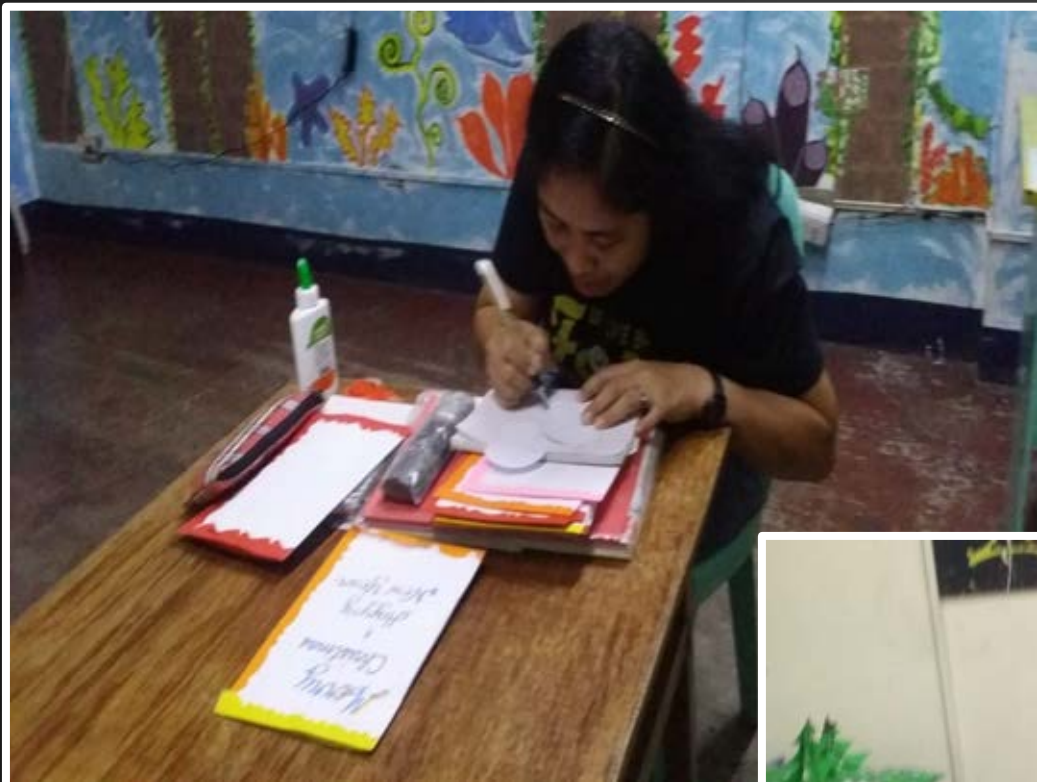


Facilitated the **Annual
